The Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra is pleased to announce the hiring of their new Concertmaster, Fabián López. López will begin with the symphony at the start of their 2014-2015 Season in their Beethoven and Blue Jeans concert being held on September 13th, 2014.

López currently holds the position of Associate Professor of Violin at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, where he has been teaching since 2007. He has previously taught at the Royal Conservatory of Music “Manuel de Falla” of Cádiz, Spain and has toured extensively through the United States, Europe, and South America, gaining recognition as a violin soloist, chamber musician, and teacher. As a soloist he has performed with orchestras in the United States, Spain, and France, and has appeared as concertmaster of the Greensboro and Asheville Symphonies in North Carolina. In the pedagogical terrain, he is an active and dedicated teacher, maintaining a studio of prize winning, talented, and committed students. He presents regular masterclasses throughout the United States, Mexico, and Europe, and during the summers he teaches at the Richard Luby International Violin Symposium in Chapel Hill and the Chamber Strings Music Workshop in Rosemont, Pennsylvania. He holds degrees from the Conservatorio Superior de Música de Málaga (Spain), Baylor University (MM), and the University of Michigan (DMA).
