The Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra will be performing Tchaikovsky's *Symphony No. 4* in two locations in October: one on October 25th in Seabrook Auditorium at Fayetteville State University, and a second on October 26th in R.E. Lee Auditorium at Pinecrest High School in Southern Pines, NC. The program for these concerts will be an exciting one. Not only will it feature the well-known, and emotional *Symphony No. 4* by Tchaikovsky, it will also feature the symphony performing Tchaikovsky's *Polonaise* from *Eugene Onegin* (one of Tchaikovsky's better known operas), Dvorak's *Slavonic Dances No.5-8*, and the world premiere of Maestro Fakhouri's newest composition called *PUNCH IT!*. This concert series will be the second of the seaon for the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra as they celebrate the 10-year anniversary of Maestro Fakhouri's appointment with the symphony.

A pre-concert talk will also take place before each concert with the professional musicians of the Fayetteville Symphony. Principal Flutist, Sarah Busman, Principal French Horn, Steve Skillman, and Principal Violist, Katie Wyatt, will lead the discussion about the pieces to be performed both evenings and what they find interesting from a musicians' perscreetive.
