Such works include: Bach's Toccata & Fugue in D minor, Dukas' The Sorcerer's Apprentice (most famously known from Disney's "Fantasia"), Harry Potter, Highlights from Wicked, the music from "Psycho", and much more! This will be a great family-oriented activity, and people are encouraged to come dressed in their Halloween costumes. Alfred E. Sturgis will be the guest conductor for this concert.
