Bragg partner for their fourth year in a row to perform their Symphonic Salute to the US Armed Forces Concert in Festival Park over Memorial Day Weekend. The concert, conducted by CPT Dae Kim of the Army Ground Forces Band, will feature musicians from both groups on the stage at Festival Park performing an evening of patriotic music to honor all our armed forces for Memorial Day.

The concert will start at 7:30pm on Sunday, May 29th in Festival Park, and is free admission.
