

## Alto, Tenor, and Baritone Saxophone Seating Audition Requirements

Saxophone Seating Audition requirements for the Fayetteville Symphony Youth Orchestra (FSYO) are listed below. This is purely for seating placement and <u>does not</u> exclude anyone from participating in FSYO.

Please note: All woodwind, brass, and percussion participants will be placed in Concert Band. Saxophone participation in Full Orchestra is dependent on the repertoire chosen for a specific semester as much of the orchestral rep does not require saxophone. Should a piece of music require saxophone in Full Orchestra, the top placed saxophones in Concert Band will be offered that opportunity.

Auditions will be held on the following days after school: Tuesday, June 5<sup>th</sup> | Monday, August 27<sup>th</sup> | Wednesday, August 29<sup>th</sup> | Wednesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>

Please indicate which day you prefer to audition on your application. You will be given an assigned audition time upon receiving your application and application fee. Your audition will last approximately 10 minutes. An audition time will not be scheduled until both the application and application fee have been received.

Please prepare the following <u>3 etudes</u>, <u>to the best of your ability</u>, for your seating audition. Each are a different level of difficulty. It is not required to perform all 3 if you cannot perform the harder excerpts.

Sightreading will also be given at the audition. No scales are required.
