



**FAYETTEVILLE SYMPHONY MUSICIANS TO PERFORM A FREE
NEW ORLEANS JAZZ CONCERT IN WESTOVER PARK
ON SEPTEMBER 14th**

Select musicians of the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra will be performing a jazz-oriented concert on Thursday, September 14th starting at 6:30pm in Westover Park on Bonanza Drive. This concert will feature dixieland jazz - the type of jazz that is most commonly heard on the streets of New Orleans. The concert is free to attend, and is an effort by the symphony to bring their talented musicians and their music to communities in Fayetteville that can't always attend a symphony concert.

Food trucks will be on site in order to purchase food, and attendees are asked to bring a lawn chair and/or blanket to sit on as those items will not be provided. No dogs or alcohol are allowed in the park. The concert will begin at 6:30pm and last approximately an hour and a half, with a short intermission. In the case of inclement weather, the concert will be moved indoors to the Westover Recreation Center.
