The Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra will be partnering with the Fayetteville Academy Chorus for their holiday concert on Saturday, December 2nd, 2017. Titled, “A Carolina Holiday,” this family-friendly concert will feature both traditional and popular holiday pieces that will help put anyone in the holiday spirit. Some of the pieces in the program will feature the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra only, and others will showcase the orchestra performing with the students of the Fayetteville Academy Chorus. Some of these pieces include Leroy Anderson’s *A Christmas Festival*, Irving Berlin’s *White Christmas*, Three Holiday Songs from *Home Alone*, *Christmas Time is Here* from *A Charlie Brown Christmas*, and many more!

The concert will begin at 7:30pm on Saturday, December 2nd, 2017 in Huff Concert Hall at Methodist University. A Pre-Concert Talk will begin at 6:45pm featuring the FSO “Music Nerd,” Music Director Stefan Sanders, Fayetteville Symphony Concertmaster Fabian Lopez, and the Fayetteville Academy Chorus Director LeeAnn Valcarcel.

Due to the exciting partnership with the Fayetteville Academy Chorus, the symphony is encouraging concertgoers to purchase their tickets in advance as they are expecting to have a near-capacity size crowd for this concert. Tickets are not guaranteed to be available for purchase at the door.
