In response to the current guidelines for public safety regarding the COVID-19 pandemic the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra must postpone or cancel the following events:

March 20th - *Sand Tunes* - **POSTPONED** - To be rescheduled

March 21st - *Salute to Youth 2020 Solo & Ensemble Festival* - **POSTPONED** - To be rescheduled

April 4th - *Musical Folktales* concert - **CANCELLED**

These difficult decisions are in the best interests of our audiences, musicians and staff. We thank you for your patience and consideration as we navigate this constantly evolving landscape. With the uncertainty of the financial impact of COVID-19 on the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra, as well as other non-profits, your support is important.

To provide flexibility, we are offering the following options for all current ticket holders for cancelled or postponed events:

- Keep your tickets and join us for rescheduled events. We will publish dates as soon as they are confirmed.
- Consider dedicating your ticket payment as a donation to the FSO. The purchase price will be credited to your account and you will be issued a receipt for your donation to support the Symphony's mission, "**To Educate, Entertain and Inspire** the citizens of the Fayetteville, North Carolina region as the leading musical resource."
- Exchange your tickets or receive credit vouchers redeemable for FSO concerts during the 2020- 2021 season.
- Request a refund to your original method of payment.
