DECEMBER 10 FEATURING GUEST CONDUCTOR ARAM DEMIRJIAN**

The Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra will be performing their annual holiday concert on Saturday, December 10 at 7:30pm in Huff Concert Hall at Methodist University. The concert will be featuring auditioning guest conductor Aram Demirjian, as well as vocal soloist Dr. Susan Durham-Lozaw of the Methodist University Music Department. This concert is great for families who want to enjoy an evening of traditional holiday music performed by a live symphony orchestra. Works to be performed this evening will include both classical and popular holiday tunes such as Gesu Bambino, Skater's Waltz, The Night Before Christmas, The Nutcracker, Sleigh Ride, Santa Claus is Coming to Town, and many more.

Aram Demirjian will be the guest conductor for this concert. Demirjian is the third of five auditioning candidates for the position of Music Director/Conductor for the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra. This concert will be considered his "audition" for the position, and the audience will have the opportunity to give their feedback on what they thought of him as a potential leader of Cape Fear's own Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra. Demirjian is currently the Music Director of the Knoxville Symphony Orchestra in Knoxville, TN.

A Pre-Concert Talk with the FSO "Music Nerd" and Aram Demirjian will begin at 6:45pm - a great opportunity to meet the guest conductor before the concert!

Tickets are \$27 for adults, \$24 for seniors and military, \$11 for students with a valid ID and children 6-18, and children 5 and under are free.
