MUSICIANS OF THE FAYETTEVILLE SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA TO PERFORM TWO CHAMBER CONCERTS IN THE UNIQUE VENUE OF ST. JOHN'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH IN DOWNTOWN FAYETTEVILLE

Professional musicians of the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra will be performing two different chamber concerts in the unique venue of St. John's Episcopal Church in Downtown Fayetteville during the month of January. These two concerts will feature classical music that represents the Baroque era of music, dating between 1600 and 1750.

On Thursday, January 14 starting at 7:30pm, musicians of the Fayetteville Symphony will be performing J.S. Bach's *Brandenburg Concertos*, which were works that became the benchmark of later Baroque music. Two weeks later on Thursday, January 28 starting at 7:30pm, musicians of the Fayetteville Symphony will be performing Antonio Vivaldi's *Four Seasons*, a Baroque work that is used for countless movie soundtracks and is still highly performed today.
