The Symphony is in the community...performing 8 concerts a year and partnering with Methodist University, Fayetteville State University, Cape Fear Botanical Garden, Cape Fear Regional Theatre, Cumberland Oratorio Singers, and Fayetteville/Cumberland County Parks and Recreation. The Symphony also brings music to young people in Head Start pre-school programs, elementary and high schools, as well as having its own Fayetteville Symphony Youth Orchestra and Summer Music Camps. Every year the Fayetteville Symphony performs a concert for over 4,500 third grade students in the Cumberland County School System exposing them to what is normally their first live symphonic concert experience.
